



2009-2010 SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- KINDERGARTEN:**
- regular backpack (not pre-school size).
 - white tennis shoes.
 - one pocket folder for homework.
 - one pocket folder for French.
- 1ST GRADE:**
- backpack.
 - white tennis shoes.
 - 3 pocket folders (labeled *Homework, French, Music*; no Trapper Keepers, please).
- 2ND GRADE:**
- One 3-ring binder (2"-3"); fabric covered with zippers are the most durable and secure. Please avoid binders with shoulder straps, as they are a tripping hazard.
 - Eleven Dividers for subjects (should be full pages with tabs; plastic ones will last the longest), to be labeled and placed in this order: *Notes To Go Home, General Information, Paper, Handwriting, Spelling, Reading, English, History, Math, Science, Map Skills, Wordly Wise, and Word Master.*
 - 12 sharpened pencils, 6 red checking pencils; no mechanical pencils, please.
 - Small package of tissues to be replaced as needed.
 - Four pocket folders labeled: *Music, French, Extra Paper* and *Homeroom.*
 - Three composition notebooks (not spiral) labeled: *Language Arts Journal, French, Math/Science Journal.*
 - Wide ruled notebook paper (not college ruled).
 - Addition and subtraction flashcards: facts 1-12 and 13-18, to be kept at home for math practice.
 - Multiplication and division flashcards 0-12, can be purchased through the school for use this Fall, to be kept at home for math practice.
 - Package of lined index cards (4" x 6" or 3" x 5").
 - White tennis shoes.
 - School ditty bag (available for purchase from the Athletic Department).
 - Backpacks with wheels are not permitted due to limited storage space and safety reasons.
 - Additional supplies will be provided by the school; please replace as needed throughout the year.

| English | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5 sharpened pencils; mechanical pencils are discouraged. - folder with pockets. - two one-subject spiral notebooks. |
| History | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - plastic pencil bag large enough to hold book-report book (available at the school store). - 3rd grade only - one-subject spiral notebook. - 4th grade only - plastic pencil bag large enough to hold the history paperback (available at the school store). - 4th grade only – two or three subject spiral notebook. |
| Math | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 4th grade only - protractor. - one-subject spiral notebook. - graph paper (no smaller than 4 squares per inch). |
| Science | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - one-subject spiral notebook, 1metric ruler to be kept in binder. |
| French | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - one-subject spiral notebook. - package of 3" x 5" index cards (lined on one side) wrapped in a rubber-band and kept in a ziploc bag. |
| Music | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - one pocket folder. |
| P.E. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - white tennis shoes. - school ditty bag, available for purchase from the Athletic Department. |

PLEASE NOTE: Students in **GRADES 3-8** will need the following additional supplies:

- **THREE RING (3") BINDER** ("*D Ring*" and "*locking system*" binders are more durable and secure than others.).
- **DIVIDERS** (for subjects) (*The dividers should be complete pieces of paper with the tabs attached - not tabs alone.*
NO "TRAPPER KEEPER" NOTEBOOKS OR FOLDERS ARE TO BE USED. "TRAPPERS" ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MANY LOST HOMEWORK AND NOTE PAPERS.).
- **PENCIL HOLDER**, which fits into the 3-ring binder.
- **PACKAGE OF TISSUES AND 4 SHARPENED PENCILS**, placed inside the pencil holder.
- **NOTEBOOK PAPER** (*with wide lines*).
- **BACKPACK** (*must fit neatly in the locker. Therefore, a collapsible bag is better than a rigid one. One that is carried on the shoulders is more efficient. See p. 15 of the Parent/Student Handbook for guidelines.*).
- **ASSIGNMENT NOTEBOOKS**, which are provided by Westminster School and will be issued on the first day of school (*There will be a fee for replacement copies.*).
- **P.E. CLOTHING** – sweats and extra shorts, shirts, and socks available for purchase from the Athletic Department (Please make checks payable to Westminster School.).
