



Remedial Academic Sessions

Academic review classes are offered only to **enrolled Westminster students**. Because these courses are designed to review Westminster's specific curriculum and to prepare students for the coming year, the classes would not be appropriate for non-Westminster students. Parents are asked to drop off the form and payment at the Westminster School office or to submit by mail.

Review of Kindergarten

This course is specifically designed to provide students with a review of the Open Court Reading and Math programs. In reading, readiness skills are emphasized along with work on beginning and ending consonant sounds, word attack skills, blending, and beginning reading. Math concentrates on beginning addition and subtraction. Handwriting practice includes correct letter formation, with emphasis on proper pencil grip and paper position.

Language Arts - Review of Grade 1 and Preparation for Grade 2

This course prepares the student for a more successful second-grade year by offering an in-depth review of necessary written and oral reading comprehension skills, vocabulary development, phonics, grammar usage, and the writing process.

Math - Review of Grade 1 and Preparation for Grade 2

This course serves as a review of the basic math skills taught in first grade, specifically place value, addition, subtraction, telling time, money, and word problems. Manipulatives and Math Lab activities are emphasized.

Language Arts - Review of Grade 2 and Preparation for Grade 3

This course prepares the student for a more successful third-grade year by offering an in-depth review of necessary skills in reading comprehension, vocabulary, phonics, grammar usage, and the writing process. Tips on study skills will also be included.

Math - Review of Grade 2 and Preparation for Grade 3

This course reviews important math skills taught in the second grade, specifically place value, word problems, multiplication, division, telling time, money, and decimals. Manipulatives and Math Lab activities are emphasized.

<p>English - Review of Grades 3 and 4 and Preparation for Grades 4 and 5</p> <p>In the area of reading, students work on vocabulary development, comprehension, and oral and silent reading for both understanding and expression. In grammar, students work on all aspects of capitalization, punctuation, and sentence structure. The writing process is also emphasized, including paragraph development, outlines, summarization, and creative writing.</p>

<p>Math - Review of Grades 3 and 4 and Preparation for Grades 4 and 5</p> <p>For students entering 4th Grade: This course reviews solving word problems; multi-digit addition, subtraction, and multiplication; division, including both short and long methods; recognition of fractions; shapes and properties; introduction of mixed numbers; functions and graphing; as well as rounding and approximation.</p> <p>For students entering 5th Grade: This course reviews solving word problems; addition, subtraction, and multiplication of multi-digit numbers; short and long division with one- and two-digit divisors; area, perimeter, and volume; addition, subtraction, and multiplication of fractions and mixed numbers; functions and graphing; probability and statistics; and the use of calculators.</p>

<p>English - Review of Grades 5 and 6 and Preparation for Grades 6 and 7</p> <p>This course focuses on reading comprehension, grammar, usage, capitalization and punctuation sentence structure, paragraph building, and writing mechanics. The principles of effective writing are addressed in depth.</p>

<p>Math - Review of Grade 5 and Preparation for Grade 6</p> <p>For students entering 6th Grade: This course reviews fractions and mixed numbers with all operations; rounding; estimation; word problems and logical thinking; negative numbers, percentages and decimals; angles, area, and volume.</p> <p>For students entering 7th Grade: This course reviews fractions and mixed numbers with all operations; decimals and percentages; the communicative, associative, and distributive laws; the order of operations; angles and shapes; statistics and ratios; volume and area; graphing; squares and cubes.</p>

<p>French Grammar and Composition and Preparation for Grades 6 & 7</p> <p>This course serves as a foundation for those students who have not had French in school or who need a few weeks of review at this grade level. It emphasizes proper pronunciation, normal beginning conversation topics, and the essentials of French I grammar.</p>
