1. What qualities make you unique? What sets you apart from others? How might your friends describe you to someone who has never met you? Give some examples that lend insight into your character and personality.
2. What book have you read that has had the greatest impact on you? Describe how it affected you, and tell why it was so important in your life.
3. What is your passion in life? Do you have a talent, hobby, or interest that makes you the person that you are? Describe this passion, what it means to you, and how you see yourself pursuing it in the future.
