>> An **INDEPENDENT**, **NON-PROFIT** institution;

>> **ACCREDITED** by the Virginia Association of Independent Schools and the National Association of Independent Schools, and a member of the Association of Independent Schools of Greater Washington;

>> **OPEN TO ALL** and **IMPRESSIVELY DIVERSE**, with students representing a wide array of races, religions, and national origins;

>> A pre-K-8th grade day school for approximately **275 BOYS AND GIRLS**, with a beautiful campus in the heart of Fairfax County, just minutes from the Capital Beltway;

>> Founded on a classical curriculum, with an **ACCELERATED**, **WELL-ROUNDED** academic program, which includes French and Latin, daily PE and athletics, performing and fine arts, frequent field trips, and a wide array of enriching extracurricular opportunities;

>> Known for small classes (ratio ranges from 1:7 - 1:18) and the **INDIVIDUAL ATTENTION** given to students, including guidance toward honorable conduct, good manners, personal presentation, articulate speech, and details that make the difference, such as a cleareyed, open expression and a firm handshake;

>> Proud of its faculty, where **MORE THAN 60%** hold advanced degrees, and each subject in every grade is taught by a specialist; and proud of its **ELEGANT FACILITY**, including art and music studios, gymnasium, and theater;

>> **RICH IN TRADITION,** with a unique history and many special events throughout the year that bond our community and provide rich experiences and lasting memories.

LOWER SCHOOL: GRADES K-2

- >> Children are taught how to be part of a caring, respectful, and responsible community. They learn good manners, independence, and self-discipline.
- >> Accelerated language arts and math programs put our students ahead. By the time children are in 2nd grade, they are reading chapter books and writing reports and creative pieces. They can reason mathematically and solve word problems involving 4-digit addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
- >> Our rich curriculum includes thinking skills, hands-on science, social studies, geography and map skills, French, and daily P.E. classes.
- >> Arts emphasis, with twice-weekly classes in both art and music, Orff instruments, choral performances, art contest, and an annual class play in which everyone participates.
- >> Many special and fun traditions, including Hat Day, holiday celebrations, Native American Day, Le Petit Déjeuner, and International Day.
- >> Seven field trips a year, including farms, museums, theaters, stores, restaurants, and more!

MIDDLE SCHOOL: GRADES 3-5

- >> Accelerated curricula in all academic classes, including pre-Algebra in 6th grade.
- >> Handwriting lessons continue through 4th grade.
- >> In addition to weekly art and music classes, students may choose to learn an instrument and join the orchestra.
- >> Students begin in-depth, sequential history studies of Western Civilization, including celebratory history days: 3rd grade – Ancient Egypt and other early civilizations; 4th grade – Ancient Greece; 5th Grade – Ancient Rome; 6th grade – Middle Ages. (The adventure continues in the upper school.)
- >> Classic literature and writing skills are emphasized.
- >> Consistent standards and daily expectations teach responsibility and good character.
- >> Regular technology and STEAM classes in our Makerspace begin in 3rd grade.
- >> Drama grows more sophisticated, with 6th graders performing a junior musical.
- >> All 6th graders serve as safety patrols.
- >> Field trips to museums, historical sites, music performances, engineering workshops, and more!
- >> After-school athletics plus a wide variety of clubs and enrichment classes.





UPPER SCHOOL: GRADES 6-8

- >> High-school level academics, including Algebra, Geometry, Biology, Chemistry/ Physics, Latin I, French II, Renaissance studies, American History, and studies of British and American literary classics.
- >> Daily guidance toward personal responsibility, aspiration, and strong study skills. A generous program of special activities and events nurture the student's intellectual, emotional, and social development.
- >> Personal attention to each student's individual progress, and help preparing for the future.
- >> Dance classes, parties, and other social events that help adolescents learn how to cultivate friendships and enjoy wholesome interactions with peers and adults.
- >> Leadership training for all students, including community service, varsity athletics, yearbook, talent shows, and being featured in traditional school celebrations.
- >> Participation by all students in high-quality arts experiences, including performing in a Shakespeare play in 7th grade and a Broadway musical in 8th grade.
- >> Advanced technology and STEAM opportunities in Makerspace.
- >> Field trips to Folger Theater, Library of Congress, music and opera performances, art exhibits, outdoor challenges and overnight camping, Williamsburg, and more!
